SUBJECT: Changes to The Edenwald 401(k) Retirement Plan Investment Choices

Effective October 25, 2023, General German Aged People's Home of Baltimore, Inc. is enhancing the fund options available in your retirement plan. The changes are summarized as follows:

Departing Fund	Replacement Funds Available for use on October 25, 2023		
T. Rowe Price Blue Chip Growth Fund, TRBCX	Vanguard Growth Index Admiral Fund, VIGAX		

These funds have similar investment objectives; however, the replacement fund has a better track record compared to its peers. If you do not want to go into the replacement fund, you will need to transfer the existing balance to a different fund prior to the availability date. Investment information related to the new fund is displayed below.

When will the departing fund balance be transferred?

On **October 25, 2023**, any balance in the departing fund will be automatically transferred to the replacement fund. All contributions previously designated to the departing fund will be directed to the replacement fund.

Will this affect my ability to access my account on the web?

Access to your account will not be affected. However, during the transfer period, you will not be able to make trades on the funds listed above.

How can I access my investment information?

You can access your account via the Internet (www.ffa401k.com) to make changes. It is recommended you periodically review your account and investment options to manage your risk levels and goals by using the online tools and the retirement calculator via your web account.

Part I. Performance Information
